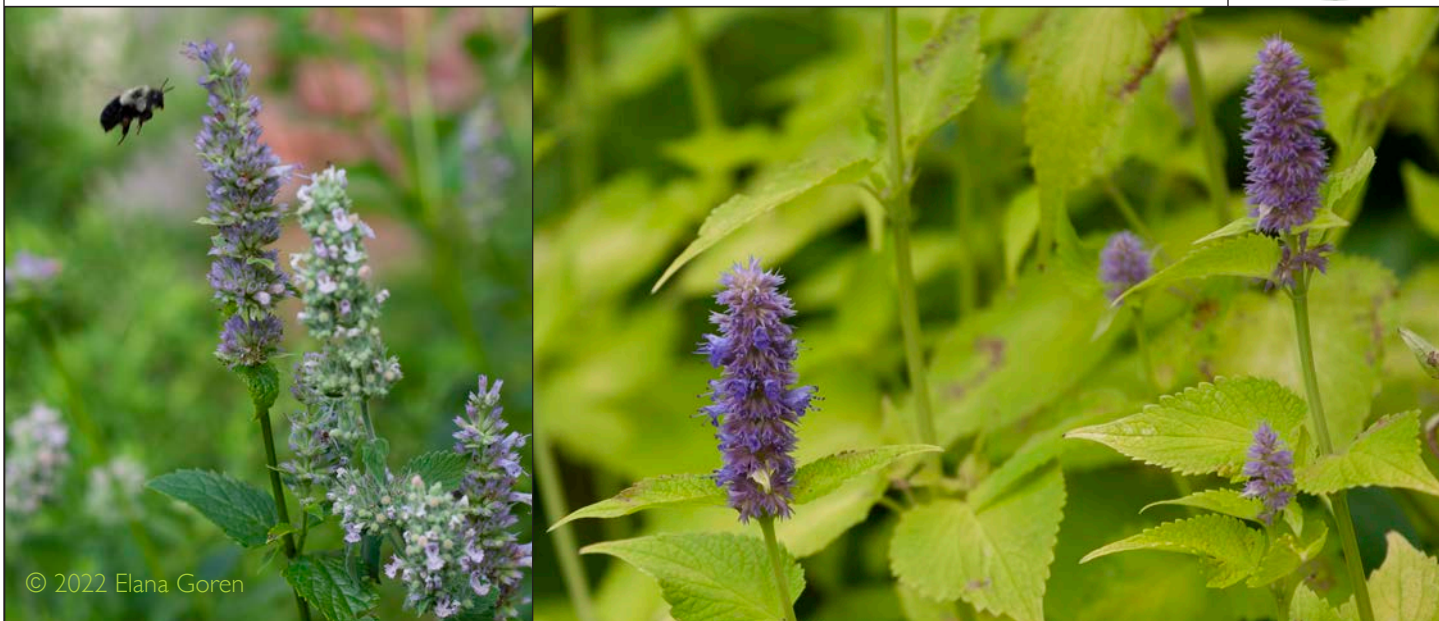


# Anise Hyssop

- Light** Full sun to partial shade
- Water** Drought-tolerant
- Soil** Adaptable, prefers well-drained soil
- Hardiness Zones** 4 – 8
- Height** 2 – 4 feet
- Spacing** 12 – 36 inches
- Bloom Times** June – September
- Bloom Color** Purple to Lavendar
- Garden Use** Native and pollinator garden, butterfly garden, cutting garden, meadow, mass-planting
- Benefits** Attracts butterflies, bees and birds. Goldfinches love to pull the seeds from spent flowers and their brilliant colors and acrobatics are fun to watch.

This low-maintenance, drought-tolerant, native perennial has edible leaves that can be used fresh in salads or dried in teas.
