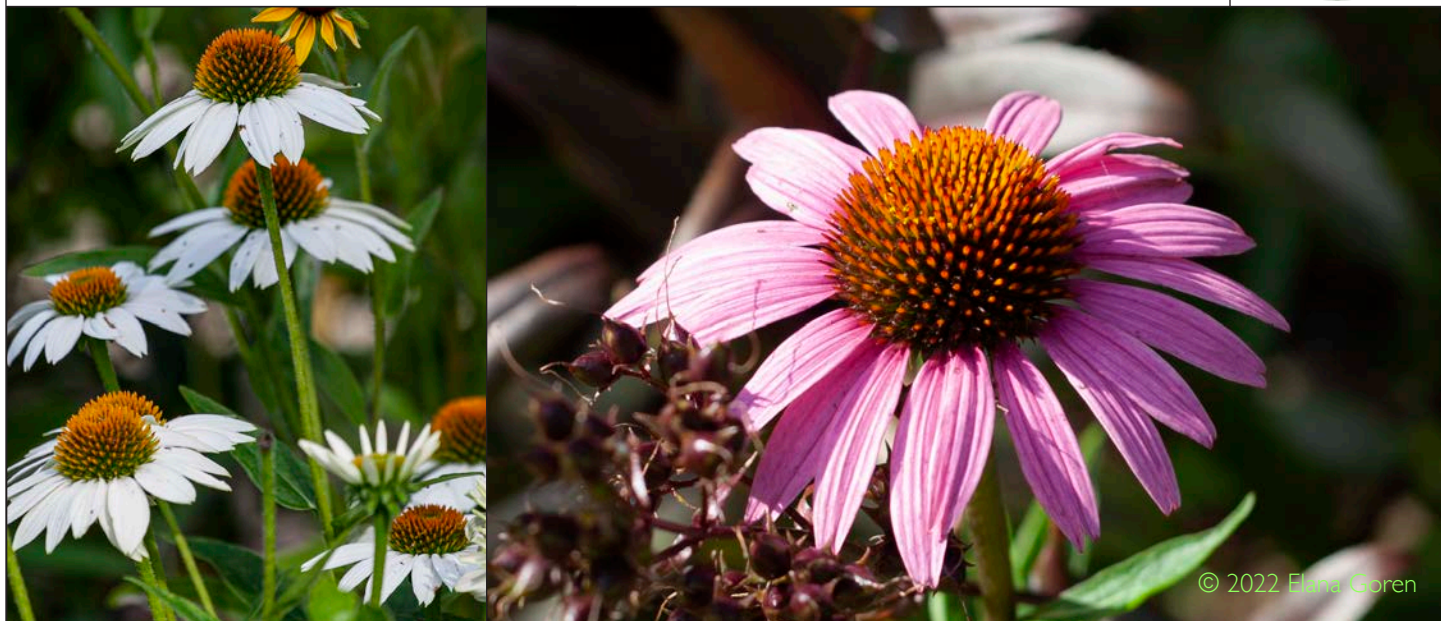


# Coneflower

Light	Full sun to partial shade
Water	Drought-tolerant
Soil	Adaptable to most soils, poor soils
Hardiness Zones	3 – 7
Height	2 – 5 feet
Spacing	12 – 24 inches
Bloom Times	June – August
Bloom Color	Pink but look for cultivars which display a variety of colors including shades of white, orange, red and yellow
Garden Use	Native and pollinator garden, butterfly garden, cottage garden, , cutting garden, meadow, mass-planting
Benefits	NY native plant that attracts pollinators and is tolerant to drought, heat and humidity. It is very easy to grow with long-lasting blooms throughout the summer. Deadheading is not required for reblooming.
