- Light Full sun to partial shade
- Water Medium to wet
- Soil Prefers moist conditions
- Hardiness Zones 4 – 9
- Height 2 – 4 feet
- Spacing 12 – 36 inches
- Bloom Times July – August
- Bloom Color Scarlet Red
- Garden Use Native and pollinator garden, butterfly garden, cutting garden, meadow, mass-planting
- Benefits This pollen and nectar producer attracts butterflies, bees and hummingbirds.  
  
Tolerates clay soil, wet soil, black walnut. Deer and Rabbit resistant.
