Allium cernuum





Light Full sun to partial shade

Water Drought-tolerant once established

Soil Adaptable, naturally found in rocky soil

Hardiness Zones 4 – 8

Height 1 to 3 feet when flowering, leaves are up to 1 foot

Spacing 12 inches

Bloom Times June - August

Bloom Color Deep pink to white

Garden Use Cottage garden, native and pollinator garden, rock garden,

butterfly garden, meadow, mass-planting

Benefits NY native plant that attracts pollinators such as hummingbirds,

butterflies and bees and is deer resistant.

Bright green tufts of leaves emerge in early spring. Arching stems grow by early summer with buds opening to an array of

pinks and whites through to late summer.

Nodding Onion is also an edible herb.
