Garden Use	Native and pollinator garden, butterfly garden, cutting garden.
Benefits	Carpet of blooms cover this aster late in the season when most other flowers are gone. Pair with late seaon Goldenrod for a beautiful purple and yellow display. When planted in masses (9 or more together) it has the mass and form of a shrub, giving a fullness to the garden where it is planted.
	Tolerates clay soil, dry soil, rocky soil. Erosion control plant. Deer and Rabbit resistant.
