

# Aromatic Aster

- Light Full sun
- Water Dry to medium
- Soil Average
- Hardiness Zones 3 – 8
- Height 1 – 3 feet
- Spacing 12 – 36 inches
- Bloom Times Late August – October
- Bloom Color Blues and purples (depending on variety)
- Garden Use Native and pollinator garden, butterfly garden, cutting garden.
- Benefits Carpet of blooms cover this aster late in the season when most other flowers are gone. Pair with late season Goldenrod for a beautiful purple and yellow display. When planted in masses (9 or more together) it has the mass and form of a shrub, giving a fullness to the garden where it is planted.  
  
Tolerates clay soil, dry soil, rocky soil. Erosion control plant.  
Deer and Rabbit resistant.
